

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

The transfer of patients will begin at 7:00 am



A physician will assess the patient's state of health and authorize the departure. If necessary, transport of a patient deemed too unstable will be postponed to later in the day.



At the time of departure, the patient will be transferred to a stretcher or wheelchair by the mobilization team.



The transfer to the room in the new hospital will be made via a covered elevated passage connected to Hôpital Saint-Luc (in about 10 minutes).



Patient will be accompanied by a nurse carrying his medication and medical file during transfer. Depending on his medical condition, a respiratory therapist or a physician may also be present.



Upon his arrival at the new hospital, patient will be registered, then taken directly to his new room, where the care team will receive him and conduct an assessment.



At the new hospital, patient will be receiving a lunch box, for dinner, and hot meal for supper.
