

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

The transfer of patients will begin at 7:00 am



A physician will assess the patient's state of health and authorize the departure. If necessary, transport of a patient deemed too unstable will be postponed to later in the day.



The patient will be transferred to a stretcher or wheelchair.



Patient will be covered with a blanket and placed in an ambulance or a Medicar vehicle. Transportation to the new hospital will follow an itinerary established in consultation with the Ville de Montréal and the Service de Police de la Ville de Montréal (SPVM).



The transfer from a room at Hôtel-Dieu to a room in the new hospital should take about 25 minutes.



Patient will be accompanied by a nurse carrying his medication and medical file during transfer. Depending on his medical condition, a respiratory therapist or a physician may also be present.



Upon his arrival at the new hospital, patient will be registered, then taken directly to his new room, where the care team will receive him and conduct an assessment.



A hot meal will be served to the patient for dinner and supper.
